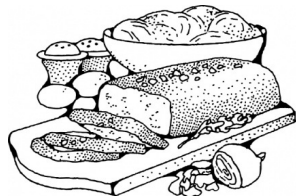
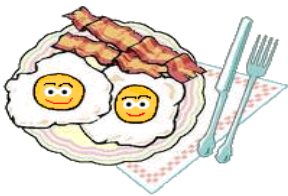
Car Show
